#### Are you READY to join the Jesus Movement in Pittsburgh?!!

This February, we have the incredible opportunity and honor to host Presiding Bishop Michael Curry at the first of a series of events at diocese across the country. In addition to presiding and preaching at our Absalom Jones service, Bishop Curry will inspire and equip us to work with other regional civic and faith leaders to engage in the essential work of healing, racial reconciliation and evangelism, taking the Good News to a broken world. This is work that all of usyoung and old—are called to do!

So what is your role as a formation leader and as someone who works with children and/or youth in the diocese? Here's the plan:

- Encourage your young people—children, youth, teens—to attend the Absalom Jones celebration Eucharist and the special breakfast with the Presiding Bishop on Saturday, February 4 beginning at 9:30 a.m.
- Participate in the creation of a GIFT for Bishop Curry, a collaboratively made altar frontal.
- Identify young people who are musicians or acolytes and encourage them to take part in the service.
- Communicate to your parish family that seeing Bishop Curry is a not-to-be-missed opportunity! You may have seen his videos—but these don't capture a fraction of the energy and passion he brings to his live preaching!
- Pray for our diocese, that we, led by our young people, may be inspired to transform our region!



What do you need to do? What's next? Although there are numerous events with the Presiding Bishop over the revival weekend, we are particularly encouraging children, teens, youth and their families to attend the Absalom Jones celebration Eucharist.

You may register as a group—note the number and ages of youth in the NOTES section of the registration form.

Please encourage your church families to attend—they must also <u>REGISTER</u> and note the number of people attending and the ages of the children in the comment section of the form. Please encourage members of your parish to come! They will not regret it!

## Alter Frontal Gift

We are going to have the kids walk paint footprints on lengths of cloth and have these sewn together to make the frontal.
