

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
Standing Committee Actions
Episcopal Diocese of Pittsburgh

At the August 8, 2011 meeting of the Standing Committee, held at Calvary Church, Pittsburgh, the following matters were considered and/or actions taken:

1. The bishop reported on his visitation to the newly reopened St. James Church, Penn Hills, to a congregation of about 70 people.
2. The Chancellor reported on property issues.
3. Consent was given for the election of the Rev. Joseph Scott Barker as Bishop Diocesan for the Diocese of Nebraska.
4. The Standing Committee appointed Steve Stagnitta, of St. Andrew's, Highland Park, to fill the District 2 vacancy in Diocesan Council left by Wes Rohr, who moved away from Pittsburgh.
5. The Standing Committee discussed the Diocesan Profile submitted by the Nominations Committee and made suggestions for certain revisions.
6. The Standing Committee continued its discussion of the recommendation of a compensation scale for the eighth Bishop of Pittsburgh.
7. The 400th Anniversary of the King James Version of the Bible will be celebrated by the diocese on November 11, 2011, with a lecture held at St. Andrew's Church, Highland Park, and on Sunday, November 13, by use of the KJV in the parishes of the diocese.
