

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
Standing Committee Actions
Episcopal Diocese of Pittsburgh

At the February 14, 2011 meeting of the Standing Committee, held at Trinity Cathedral, Pittsburgh, the following matters were considered and/or actions taken:

1. The Committee appointed Ms. Bessie Butler, of Holy Cross Church, Homewood, to the Trinity Cathedral Chapter.
2. Bishop Price reported on the decisions of the Commission on Ministry and on the Presiding Bishop's visit during Holy Week of 2011. He also consulted with the Standing Committee on his pastoral letter to the separated parishes.
3. Received a report from Ms. Dana Phillips, Chairman of the Nominations Committee and a timeline for the Election of the Eighth Bishop of Pittsburgh from the Transition Committee.
4. A progress report on the Anglican Covenant discussion was given. It was decided to send additional resources to the parishes to help in their studies and discussions and a form will be developed for parishes to use to submit feedback.
5. A report on the Collaboration Committee's joint clergy conference, called "Making All Things New", was given. The conference will be led by the Credo Institute and focus on changing patterns of ministry in the 21st century.
6. The Standing Committee discussed goals to be set for the coming year.
