Since its establishment in 1993, the Carol Teti Memorial Organ Scholarship Committee has worked to overcome the continually growing trend of fewer organists both locally and throughout the nation. To combat "the vanishing organist," the Committee raises scholarship money through fall and spring recitals and other fundraising events to support Indiana University of Pennsylvania students who wish to study organ and church music. The committee has awarded over \$125,000 in scholarships to over seventy students.
