Guidelines for Applications to the Growth Fund for Environmental Purposes

The Growth Fund Committee and the Board of Trustees are dedicated to assisting participating parishes in maintaining and preserving their physical plants, with an emphasis on helping smaller parishes that may not be able to afford such repairs. The Growth Fund Committee and Board of Trustees also recognize the importance of encouraging parishes to explore energy-saving projects in our church buildings. Accordingly, we must balance funding for energy-saving projects with funding the urgent needs of parishes for repairs and unforeseen emergencies that affect the integrity of our buildings.

Beginning in 2022, \$20,000 of the annual Growth Fund allotment will be designated to address energy-saving projects. Grant amounts, not to exceed \$1,000, are limited to 50% of the project cost for parishes that wish to address environmental issues in their buildings.

Guidelines

Parishes may apply for these funds to address smaller environmental, non-urgent projects within the parish. Electric and gas companies may do energy assessments and parishes are urged to contact these companies before making application to the Growth Fund.

If there are funds remaining in the allocation at year-end, additional applications may be submitted to the fund.

Priority will be given to those parishes who have not received grants in the past.

Parishes will be asked to match the amount granted by the Growth Fund Committee and Board of Trustees with its own funds, which may include sweat equity.

Growth Fund Grants for Environmental Projects Information

Growth Fund grants for environmental projects are available on a limited basis to parishes that contribute annually via the Growth Fund assessment. \$20,000 will be made available for these grants. Grant amounts are limited to 50% of the project cost, not to exceed \$1,000.

Applications are reviewed by the Growth Fund Committee, which has six members: two members elected at convention, two members of Diocesan Council, and two members of the Board of Trustees. The Growth Fund Committee evaluates applications and makes a recommendation to the Board of Trustees for final approval. The Growth Fund Committee meets throughout the year as necessary to discuss grant applications. As such, there is a rolling submission process. The Committee provides equal consideration to all eligible applicants.

As part of the application process, parishes must obtain written quotes from contractors and/or vendors. As a general rule, the following rubric will apply:

• Projects under \$5,000 require at least one quote

When soliciting quotes, please be aware that selected contractors will be required to provide a certificate of insurance listing the parish and Diocese as additional insured before any work begins. Also please ensure the contractor has any required licenses (e.g., a license for work in the City of Pittsburgh). If you are struggling to get written quotes, we encourage you to ask neighboring parishes to find out who they have used for similar work, or to call or e-mail the Diocesan Office (office@episcopalpgh.org).
