The committee took up the one pending item of business carried over from 2022, which was a request to look at some revision of diocesan canons which would allow appointments to the General Convention Deputation should last minute events result in a risk of a less than full presence at a General Convention. After discussion the committee has crafted a proposal which is very limited in its scope. The goal was to provide the greatest support for the decisions made by the Pittsburgh diocesan annual conventions through its election process. The committee found no other matters needing our immediate attention.
