

## TRINITY CATHEDRAL CHAPTER

There have been many positives in the life of the Cathedral over the past year:

- Average Sunday attendance has increased from 53 in 2022 to 73 in 2023. This year we had 13 new pledgors who made over \$40,000 in new pledges.
- Lay involvement in ministries has become much more robust with many more people acting as acolytes, lectors, ushers, etc. The outreach ministry has become more vibrant with new lay leadership and volunteers and there is an active newcomer ministry.
- We completed and are executing a new Strategic Plan that calls for growth and investment across several areas.
- Our website is newly designed and more attractive and informative to visitors. The same is true of our communications to parishioners which have been upgraded in terms of quality and quantity.
- We are developing a set of emergency plans that will help responsible parties react in a time of need.
- We have made numerous improvements to our physical plant over the past few years including a new roof, the repair of significant water damage, and new signage among other projects. We are presently planning significant renovations to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors.
- We are successfully attracting events at the Cathedral, with an event being held every weekend for the remainder of the year.
- Management and governance have been improved. We hired a full-time Office Manager to help with this growth, the Executive Committee has been expanded, and the Chapter has agreed to meet more frequently. Bonnie-Marie Yager-Wiggan was elected Cathedral Canon for Formation and Parish Life.
