Founded in 2015 as a direct response to the disconnect between food waste, hunger, and environmental sustainability, 412 Food Rescue brings perfectly good surplus food to individuals and families experiencing food insecurity. Volunteers transport this food from donors to nonprofit

partners through an innovative mobile app – <u>Food Rescue Hero</u>.

412 Food Rescue works with local food businesses and retailers (grocery stores, restaurants, wholesalers, farmer's markets, etc.) by rescuing their surplus food and transporting it directly to nonprofit and community-based organizations (shelters, family support centers, housing authority sites, etc.) where the food is provided to individuals and families..





Their volunteers, also known as Food Rescue Heroes, are at the core of 412 Food Rescue's success.

They have a model of food recovery and redistribution that not only enables access to healthy food, but gets food to where people already are – overcoming barriers like transportation and time. 87% of the food rescued is fresh food; primarily produce, meat, dairy, bread, and more.
