Philippians 4:1-9


My brothers and sisters, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, my beloved.






We are now at a point of release. Let's invite ourselves into new ways of being and understanding by engaging in this exercise of prayer and release.

- Pathos appealing to em otion, values
- Ethos reputation and character
- Logos reasoned discourse, dem onstration of facts, statistics



Use W hy, How, and W hat to Think About Your Church

- Values (why we do m ission)
- Ethos (how we do m ission)
- Practice (what we do in ourm ission)

People don't give to your church because you "do church." They give because they've connected with yourm ission, not yourm ission statem ent. They give because you've communicated the W hy of why you exist.
